

1. Processing your personal data

1.1 Purpose of leconti.lu internet site

2. Exercising your rights

2.1 Your rights

In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR [Art. 12](#) and [Art. 23](#)), you have the following rights to help you manage and protect your personal data.

Right of access ([Art. 15](#))

You can request to know all the personal data that have been collected and how they are used.

Right to rectification ([Art. 16](#))

You can request that your data be updated, completed or corrected.

Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) ([Art. 17](#))

Right to restriction of processing ([Art. 18](#))

You can request that the processing of your data for a specific purpose be suspended.

Right to data portability ([Art. 20](#))

You can request that your data are not subject to certain types of data processing or certain uses.

2.2 Exercising your rights

You can exercise your rights summarised in point 2.1 above by sending an email or a letter to the addresses mentioned under 1.3.

In order to ensure that your request is legitimate, you must include a copy of a valid proof of identity with your request. This will be kept as proof for 2 years after your request.

The purpose of the processing, the processing itself and the controller in charge of the information which you send to us in order to exercise your rights are identical to those mentioned in points 1.2 and 1.3 on this page.

4. Cookies

4.1 Google analytics performance cookies

leconti.lu uses the WordPress Content Management System. The Google Analytics services of the American company, Google Inc are integrated into WordPress which states that it uses the data collected anonymously based on the procedure indicated by Google (« anonymizelp »).

Google Analytics performance cookies are used to analyse statistics and help Conti 1871 SàRL understand how users browse its internet site.

For example, these cookies are used to estimate how many people visit the site and pick up errors.

Conti 1871 SàRL uses the data collected to improve the content, features and performance of its internet site in order to provide a better online experience for its visitors.

Description of Google Analytics performance cookies

Cookie name	Validity period	Description
_ga	2 years after each update	Used to distinguish between the users.
_gat	10 minutes after each update	Used to manage the number of query sent to servers.
_gid	1 day after each update	Used to create a random user log in related to pages visited.
__utma	2 years after each update	Used to distinguish users and sessions.
__utmb	1 day after each update	Used to determine new sessions and visits.
__utmc	End of the last session	Used to determine if the internet user is a new user.
__utmz	6 months after each update	Use to determine how the internet user came to the site.
__utmv	2 years after each update	Used to save user data.
_utmt_b	1 day after each update	Used to save user data.
